V. APPLICANT SIGNATURE

Section 23a of the state construction code of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1523A, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or a residential structure. Violators of section 23a are subjected to civil fines.

Permit fee under \$90.00 includes one (1) inspection; fees from \$ 90.00 to \$ 120.00 include two (2) inspections and fees over \$ 120.00 include at least three (3) inspections.

IX. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Plumbing work shall not be started until a permit has been issued or other approval has been granted. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Plumbing Code.

No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the Job Location and Permit Number.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six (6) months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six (6) months after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX (6) MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.**

If you are not sure whether a permit is appropriate, contact your local inspector, or the township clerk at 767-3366. Code questions may be directed to the local inspector.
